2018-19 immunization requirements for Ballard County Schools

If you have a child entering preschool, kindergarten, sixth grade, or transferring to Ballard County Schools for the 2018-19 school year, the following health requirements must be met to comply with Kentucky state regulations and will be strictly enforced. Parents will be asked to provide a Social Security number and birth certificate for each child.
