**Weather make-up days:** 1<sup>st</sup> weather day will use banked time, no make-up for students; 2<sup>nd</sup> day, last day for students will be increased to a full day of instruction; 3<sup>rd</sup> day, Feb. 18; 4<sup>th</sup> day, March 15; 5<sup>th</sup> day, May 20; 6<sup>th</sup> day, May 21; 7<sup>th</sup> day, May 22; 8<sup>th</sup> day, May 23; 9<sup>th</sup> day, May 24; 10<sup>th</sup> day, May 28; 11<sup>th</sup> day, May 29; 12<sup>th</sup> day, May 30; 13<sup>th</sup> day, May 31; 14<sup>th</sup> day, April 1 of spring break; 15<sup>th</sup> day, April 2 of spring break; 16<sup>th</sup> day, April 3 of spring break; 17<sup>th</sup> day, April 4; 18<sup>th</sup> day, April 5 of spring break. \*If weather days occur after designated make-up days, those days automatically roll down to the next available make-up day (i.e., if the third weather day occurs after Feb. 18, Mar. 15 will be the 3<sup>rd</sup> make-up day, etc.).

**Families, staff and community members should be aware** that an excess of weather-cancelled days could push student days well past the planned last day of May 17, or take up part of spring break. We understand that many vacations are planned using the original calendar's off days; however, we strongly encourage families to check cancellation policies for vacations set for immediately after the planned end of school, or during spring break, in case school is still in session.
