**Weather make-up days will be used as follows:** First and second days will use banked time, no make-up for students; days 3-12 will use NTI for virtual learning. Any days after day 12 will be addressed by the district.

**\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*** Nontraditional instruction (NTI) days allow Ballard County Schools to continue providing quality instruction through the use of technology. During NTI days, students are expected to follow an NTI schedule and participate in all scheduled activities.

**Minimum School Term Per KRS 158.070:** The minimum school term shall be 185 days, including at least 1,062 instructional hours in no less than 170 student attendance days. A board of education may extend its year beyond the minimum term. “Student attendance day” means any day that students are scheduled to be at school to receive instruction, and encompasses the designated start and dismissal time.
